

# **BRISLEY PARISH COUNCIL**

## **METAL DETECTING POLICY**

Adopted: 1<sup>ST</sup> February 2023

Review Schedule: Three yearly

The Parish Council occasionally receives requests for permission from individuals or organisations wishing to carry out metal detecting on land owned, leased or managed by the Council.

This document sets out the policy of the Parish Council regarding such requests and is effective from the date adopted.

It supersedes any previous arrangements that may have existed, and any such arrangements made between the Parish Council, its tenants, grazing rights holders and/or other persons or organisations will cease to have effect from the date of adoption of this policy.

Local authorities have the power to ban metal detecting and other activities through the use of byelaws. In the absence of any such byelaws or other specific restrictions on metal detecting on land owned, leased or managed by the Parish Council, the use of metal detectors on such land is regulated by this policy.

**Metal detecting is not permitted on any land owned, leased or managed by the Parish Council, including any land to which the public has a right of access, including:**

- Brisley Green (North & South)
  - Harpers Green
  - The Hill
  - The Amenity Area (including Jubilee Wood, Centenary Field, the allotments and play area).
  - The Burial Ground
