## **4. To consider the recommendations of the working party in respect of re-opening the play area.**

Council considered the recommendations of the working party which, following a recent risk assessment and the inspection of the equipment, recommended opening the play area with relevant signage. - 3PL/2020/0710/F - Maltings Farm, Gateley Road - New Single Dwelling, swimming pool, Garden Studio. Change of Use 0.5 Acre Agricultural Land to Domestic Curtilage. Council agreed to submit a 'no comment' response.
- 3PL/2020/0685/HOU - Church Cottage, Church Street - Single Storey Extension to Side. Council agreed to submit a 'no objections but would expect the materials used in the extension to be an appropriate match to the existing building, and in keeping with the surrounding conservation area' response.
